In 2004, over 9,117 Americans lost their lives in an intersection-related crash. As a result, FHWA and AASHTO have recognized the critical need to address the issue of intersection safety. This interactive webinar will present the findings of a AAA-sponsored program to implement low-cost safety improvements at hundreds of intersections throughout Michigan and Wisconsin. The webinar will first focus on the basics of how to conduct an intersection safety audit. This will include what to look for during a site visit, road user identification, collision data, operational, geometric and human factors analyses.
