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IDOT plans \$10.22 million in repairs for Harrison County roads

Iowa's Department of Transportation (IDOT) has issued its tentative Iowa Highway Program for 2007-2011. There are 14 Harrison County projects listed, totaling \$10.22 million over five years.

The IDOT announced the program at the Iowa Transportation Commission meeting, Oct. 10. It will be approved at a later date.

2007 PROJECTS

Harrison County projects include a few for 2007. The washing of the Blair Bridge over the Missouri River will cost \$15,000 in 2007, '08, '09, '10, and '11.

The paving of Highway 30 will be accomplished in 2007, from Missouri Valley east to Logan, 6.7 miles, at a cost of \$1,000,000.

Right of way work on a proposed culvert extension will be done in 2007 for a crossing of a creek 3.9 miles south of Pisgah on Highway 183 at a cost of \$9,000.

2008 PROJECTS

In 2008, the IDOT plans to expend \$1,453,000 to grade and pave Interstate 29 from the Boyer River and two farm drives, north from Loveland .09 miles. The department will also spend \$3,143,000 for a bridge replacement as part of that project, and \$10,000 for right of way.

Also in 2008, the plan calls for bridge deck overlay on I-29 at Highway 30 in Missouri Valley at a cost of \$308,000; a bridge deck overlay on I-29 three miles south of County Road F-20 at the Soldier River, for \$310,000; the bridge washing at Blair; and culvert extension at the creek 3.9 miles south of Pisgah on Highway 183. That will cost \$110,000; and the IDOT plans to do a bridge replacement on Highway 183, 0.5 miles south of the Monona County line, for \$257,000.

2009 PROJECTS

In 2009, the IDOT plans call for the \$15,000 for the Blair Bridge washing; \$9,000 for right of way on a bridge replacement proposed for a stream 6.4 miles southwest of Dunlap on Highway 30; bridge deck overlay on Highway 127 over Allen Creek, 8.5 miles west of Highway 30, for \$167,000; and \$9,000 for right of way on a proposed bridge replacement over the Soldier River on Highway 183, one mile south of the Monona County line.

2010 PROJECTS

In 2010, the plan calls for a bridge deck overlay at Young's Ditch on Highway 30, 3.8 miles east of the Nebraska line, for \$260,000.

2011 PROJECTS

Projects for 2011, include a bridge overlay on Interstate 29, over the Union Pacific Railroad 0.3 miles north of Highway 30, for \$332,000; another I-29 bridge overlay for the ditch 1.6 miles north of County Road F-20, for \$438,000; the \$15,000 for the Blair Bridge washing; \$1,150,000 for a bridge replacement on the stream 6.4 miles southwest of Dunlap on Highway 30; and a bridge replacement on Highway 183, over the Soldier River, one mile south of the Monona County line, for \$1,369,000.
