

2007 WSDOT Remembers

The Give 'em a Brake Campaign, while an important year-round message, capitalizes on spring and summer roadway work to market the continued importance of work zone safety. We encourage each of you to take this time to remember our fallen WSDOT workers and their families by attending the April 5 Work Zone Memorial and Remembrance Event.

This year, on April 5, each region will host an informal work zone safety event from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., with the statewide Work Zone Memorial web cast to the location from 12:30 to 1 p.m. During this voluntary event, you can see some of the newest safety gear on the market and learn more about WSDOT's Give em a Brake campaign. Beginning at 12:30 p.m., WSDOT executives and family members will speak from Olympia headquarters to all WSDOT staff, and we will read the names of our 56 fallen workers.

To highlight our continued strong safety expectation, regional safety offices will offer additional information to employees, and you can view the latest safety gear, a montage of worker safety commercials, public service announcements plus enjoy refreshments and gifts.

Again, we hope you join us for the the **2007 Work Zone Memorial on Thursday, April 5, 2007 at the WSDOT HQ Building in Olympia**. Safety events will be held simultaneously between **11 a.m. and 1 p.m.** **The Memorial event will occur and be broadcast between 12:30 and 1 p.m.**
