***New Developments in Emergency Traffic Control:
MUTCD Section 6I – Incident Management -
What it May Mean for You***

This webinar will focus on the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Section 6I – Incident Management and NFPA Standards 1500 and 1561. You will learn what the new guidelines may mean for members of the emergency response and roadway safety communities.

Critical aspects of Chapter 6 and 6I of the MUTCD, along with the emergency traffic control aspects of NFPA Standards 1500 and 1561 will be discussed. The session will focus on the emergency traffic control general requirements, along with the requirements for minor, intermediate, and major duration incidents. Safe positioning of response apparatus and appropriate PPE will also be described. The emergency traffic control requirements will be related to the activities of all emergency responders (i.e., fire, rescue, police, emergency medical services, towing and recovery personnel, and hazardous materials contractors). In order to assist with program implementation; solutions on advance warning, channelizing, flagging, and apparatus positioning will be discussed.
